## NEED

### Why new marching band uniforms?

The current marching band uniforms are over 25 years old, more than double the 10 to 12 year life expectancy. The current uniforms are very outdated, the sizes are limited, the zippers are failing and the accessories are broken. Most importantly, there are just not enough uniforms to dress the entire band. This style cannot be matched or ordered as the original company has gone out of business. The new uniforms will be lighter weight, easily adjustable, repairable and replaceable and the conservative style can be used for many years to come. The Preble Band sounds first rate and now it is necessary to match their look to the sound.

### Why new concert attire?

The current formal concert attire consists of very worn, ill-fitting black gowns for women and black tuxedo jackets for men. There are only enough to fit two of the five choirs at Preble and there is no formal concert attire for the orchestra. New black gowns and tuxedo jackets will be used by choir, orchestra and band students so they will look as professional as they sound.

## CHALLENGE

As you can imagine, there is a huge cost associated to "Dress the Department". Our goal is to raise \$100,000 by May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012. Once we have the funds, the three month manufacturing process can begin and the Marching Band uniforms and formal concert attire will be ready for the start of the 2012-2013 school year.

To outfit the entire department, 200 complete Marching band uniforms, 255 women's concert gowns and 100 tuxedo jackets, ties and cummerbunds will need to be purchased. An endowment fund will also be started for uniform and formal wear up-keep and for future purchases.

Stanbury Uniforms of Brookfield, Missouri has been chosen to provide our department with the marching band uniforms and concert attire.
